## **Candidate motivational statement**

In the statement, please demonstrate your expertise and experience in the area of sustainable and digital trade facilitation, and specifically related to:

- i. development of policy recommendations
- ii. development of e-business standards, and/or
- iii. project management.

I started my professional experience as a customs inspector at the Head Customs Administration on Air Transport in 2014. This experience helped me to understand how customs operate with respect to international trade and supply chains, to use effective tools and information in dealing with the international movement of goods, to manage crises associated with the cross-border movement of goods, and to specialize in-depth customs skills. Further, working at the State Customs Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan enhanced a solid degree of expert knowledge, as well as extensive international experience.

Taking into consideration my experience in the government sector, I adore working with civil society groups, the private sector, and administrative bodies. I have had the opportunity to work in a wide range of fields regarding the economy and customs systems, each with unique goals and priorities. This broadened my understanding of related fields, allowing me to be agile in my decision-making, ensuring all choices align with greater missions and strategic objectives. My current job is regarding trade facilitation where I have been working for almost 5 years. As a part of my work, I prepare recommendations, propose changes in the legislation, and supervise the activity of the trade participants. In addition, our team analyzes the cost and time indicators associated with international trade. Thus, since 2019 I participated as an expert in the survey on Easy Doing Business. As a result, I have been awarded a certificate of Appreciation for the contribution to the report "Doing Business 2020".

The main project that I worked on was the "Green Corridor" gating system. This system is a local trusted trader program that has been implemented in Azerbaijani customs since 2019. This project implies simplification of the customs procedures for selected foreign trade participants. It brings a new logic to conducting customs control and customs clearance with more flexible and transparent tools.

The next project was reinstallation the system of the customs intermediaries that include customs brokerage, customs carrier, and Authorized Economic Operator. The last, as the main tool of trade facilitation, complete the project of the "Green Corridor" gating system. This project accelerated trade operations and became one of the most effective advantages for managing international trade.

Increasing the level of knowledge and skills of those who are involved in trade operations is also important. For this reason, through seminars and conferences, we informed both trade participants and third parties not only about the new systems but also about any other initiatives held by customs authorities.

Moreover, during the academic period of 2019-2020, I got the full scholarship for the advanced master's program in the College of Europe in the specialization of European Economic Integration and Business. In my master's thesis, I analyzed the benefits of trade facilitation and in the methodology of the research, I applied the Trade Gravity model to examine international trade between Azerbaijan and 136 trade partners in the period of 1992 to 2018. The main purpose of the statistical model was to determine the factors that significantly impede trade facilitation and to find solutions. Currently, I am working on my PhD dissertation "Promoting export of the ICT based services".
