Passionate about standardization and digitalization, I am enthusiastic to renew my engagement toward UN/CEFACT and apply to pursue a second mandate as the UN/CEFACT Vice Chair.

I got involved in the UN/CEFACT in 2016 and I did introduce the concepts of Smart Containers and Digital Twin. I did lead successfully the first international standards on smart containers (IoT) for supply chain. I did lead successfully as well the UN/CEFACT Cross Industry supply chain track and trace. Since then, I did participate actively in many UN/CEFACT groups (e.g., Advisory Group on Advanced Technology) and conferences (e.g. Internet of Things, Blockchain, Application Programming Interfaces (APIs), etc.) and did promote UN/CEFACT activities in various manners.

With more than 20 years of experience in research, development and innovation in international environments, I have managed multiple programs and projects. I have a solid experience as trainer, teaching various Computer Science related courses at the University of Ottawa (Canada) and Université d'Aix-Marseille (France). I also have experience within the public sector: I worked as a business analyst at the Canadian Federal government (Health management module at the Correctional Service Canada) for more than 3 years. This combines with my significant experience in the private sector including at Nortel Networks (Canada) working on research and standardization of numerical TV services and then at Traxens (France) where I was responsible for managing the innovation and standards development program related to global end-to-end multimodal door-to-door tracking and monitoring solutions. Currently, my focus is on driving standardization for trade facilitation and digitalization, collaborating with relevant intergovernmental organizations and non-profit and associations.

I hold a Ph.D. and master's degree in computer sciences from the School of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, Ottawa, Canada. I am proficient in multiple programming languages, I have written multiple articles and book chapters around SOA, Web Servies APIs and analyzing non-functional requirements in Service Oriented Architecture with the user requirements notation.

My academic background has contributed to my leadership capabilities and innovation mindset demonstrated during my involvement at the UN/CEFACT. Inventor and innovative, I enjoy solving complex problems that require combining Technical Background, Business Intelligence, Strategic Development and Negotiation Skills.

I do enjoy working on international trade facilitation. My first experience in standards development was in 2006 as Nortel Networks employee at the International Telecommunication Union (ITU-T, a UN sister organization) on IP-TV Focus Group. As part of my standardization work with Nortel Networks as well, I did found in 2007 the OMG Telecom PSIG Group. I chaired the Telecom PSIG Group and identified and addressed SOA gaps to be adopted in critical mission applications, such as telecommunication. As chair of this group, I organized the OMG Telecom Information Day in

Washington D.C.

Currently, as part of my mandate as the UN/CEFACT Transport & Logistics Vice Chair, I actively contribute to the trade facilitation that has to be digital and green for more efficiency and resiliency. During my mandate for the period of 2019-2023, I have managed the strategic planning and coordination of the UN/CEFACT programme of work between Plenary sessions making sure the UN/CEFACT activities comply with its mandate, terms of reference and procedures.
