I hope that you are well and I send you best wishes for which will undoubtedly be an interesting and important year ahead.

Please could you advise whether or not the UK could support the attached project proposal.

This project is a key further step in the reference data model work that we have completed in the supply chain (CSRDM) and multimodal (MMT RDM) projects.

This project will create a published overarching Buy/Ship/Pay Reference data model under which the SCRDM and MMT RDM will be subset RDMs.

In fact, this overarching data model already exists because it was an essential step during the SCRDM and MMT projects but it was never formalised. It will be very important to formalise it to be the anchor for future aligned developments across the international sales and transport contract and operational data exchange structures.

This also, of course, is the final step to achieve global support for work which originated in SITPRO during the early 2000s.
