Articles are published on this page by individuals without approval of either the Secretariat or Bureau. The Secretariat has gotten in touch with the owner of the page (a UN/CEFACT expert); the owner has since given administrator rights to the Chair of the Bureau. Although this is an unofficial initiative, the Secretariat is verifying with the UNECE Information Unit on applicable UN rules and copyright issues. 6a. Report from Secretariat	The Secretariat reported on a workshop on agricultural trade co-organised with UNESCAP in Bangkok on 21 December 2015. The basis of this workshop was the UNNExT Handbook on Implementing UN/CEFACT eBusiness Standards in Agricultural Trade. Very positive feedback was received from participants.	
	 Outcomes of other meetings in Bangkok were: The role of standards (in particular UN/CEFACT standards) for developing countries to be suggested to the Prime Minister of Thailand as one of the themes of the G77 meeting in February; Thailand may host a reception during the UN/CEFACT Forum in Bangkok (26-30 September); and A half-day conference/workshop on UN/CEFACT standards could be organised for policy makers in Thailand in parallel with the Forum. 	
	The Secretariat will communicate with the Forum Organizing Committee on the administrative/logistical aspects.	
	The Secretariat also provided a brief update on the initiative on traceability of textiles. There was a conference call on 21 December with stakeholders from the private and public sectors to brainstorm existing initiatives and identify gaps. There appears to be a lot of interest and potential for work in this area. The report of the meeting will be circulated soon.
