It was suggested to use the Oxford Dictionary or the International Accounting Body (UK) for the definitions under section 6.2 instead of Wikipedia There was some discussion of whether it was appropriate to mention EDIFICAS. The	The final draft will be sent back to the project team for revision.

	conclusion was that this is not a problem since it's an organisation not a company.
3g. CII	The Supply Chain Domain prepared two versions of the Cross Industry Invoice XML
announcement on website	schema, one with coupled and one without coupled (uncoupled) code lists. It was explained that there were advantages to both versions: coupled allows to encourage the use of controlled code lists; uncoupled allows a flexible version that either allows to use controlled code lists that are more recent than the fixed schema version and also allows to use user-defined code lists. This should encourage wider use. It was explained that UN/CEFACT internal procedures had been properly followed. The Bureau recognized this important contribution.
	The uncoupled version of the CII was a direct result of requests made by CEN. These requests are often made with very short notice. It was suggested to make a request to CEN to check whether they have procedural rules on this subject, and whether they could be shared.
