3e. Use of wikidefinitions in deliverables	The Bureau discussed the use of official definitions in the documents. It was noted that the use of Wikipedia and other wiki-type sources might be problematic as these pages are not stable sources as they can be freely edited, modified without notice and as their hyperlinks may change. Therefore, it should be attempted to refrain from using such sources, basing definitions on more authoritative sources. However, if Wikipedia has been used, it is recommended to indicate that this is a working definition and that other definitions may be found elsewhere. The concern was raised that the working definition could potentially contradict the official definition and that this needs to be taken into account when providing definitions. It was suggested to use the claim that the used working definition(s) "may not necessarily coincide with the official definition(s)". VC Probert mentioned that as ISO is also working on this issue, it might be worth checking with ISO to be in line regarding the definitions used. During the forum it will be highlighted that that Wikipedia and wiki-type sources should not be used and/or presented as authoritative source(s). It strives to avoid such sources in UN/CEFACT documents, attempting to use authoritative definitions instead.
