There are three levels of harmonization intended here: <a href="pre-harmonization">pre-harmonization</a> within the domains, <a href="harmonization">harmonization</a> within Library Maintenance and <a href="sub-setting">sub-setting</a> within such RDMs. It is not intended that this sub-setting modify the core components (this would require official submissions through Library Maintenance). The long-term maintenance was also brought up as a subject, which will be a topic for all RDM; this would need to be further discussed at a later time.
