The Bureau thanked the secretariat for preparing the briefing note and made no comments on the content of the document. 2b. Procedures for joint projects in general	Discussion should continue specifically on ISO TC 154 topics. The Secretariat suggested distinctions on: • New work items being launched and which will result in the creation of deliverables of both organizations. In this this case, joint procedures on the project should be created; and	

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	Work that is supporting projects that have already been completed within UN/CEFACT eg. the MMT RDM. In this case this would be liaison work in order to ensure encourage harmonization of other organization with UN/CEFACT standards.	
2c. How to maintain RDMs	Discussion was opened on how to move RDMs from the project based deliverables and transition them to maintainable library subsets of the CCL in coordination with the update to the CCL. A suggestion was made to harmonize the RDMs using the assistance of the Domains. A concern was raised that this is not a small procedural change but might result in some serious changes in the overall working of the CCL and it would also heighten the work on EDIFACT. Another suggestion was made that there is need to examine UN/CEFACT business processes concerning all deliverables, and also identify the linkages between the different activities in the overall scheme of UN/CEFACT work.

4a. Hangzhou Forum	 Deadline for proposals for conferences is 25 June 2018. The following are being prepared for submission: Secretariat proposes a topic on traceability / value chains. T&L will likely propose a topic after their F2F meeting this week. Orchestration is interested in perhaps a workshop on methodologies (similar to MRI – modelers' reference initiative) (similar also to an M&T initiative of an open day during a previous Forum for questions and answers). Deadline for domain/project agendas is 6 August 2018. The Secretariat informed the bureau that registration on the website is now ready but website will only be launched once the bureau has decided on the conferences to be held. The registration will be done on CUE and the secretariat should be able to provide statistics of which experts are attending particular workshops. The Bureau requested more information on the visa process, especially concerning a possible 6-day visa-free possibility and the conditions for this.
