The Secretariat presented the modified text following up on the comments from the 7 January Bureau call. The Bureau expressed its appreciation to the Secretariat for the editing. Question was raised why in paragraph 6 the accent is put only on Blockchain. We might want to reduce the emphasis on Blockchain as we have already delivered on this topic; but the current text is acceptable. The text was modified accordingly. Reference to other standards development organizations was added to paragraph 4. The first paragraph giving the history of the proposition was modified; the consensus agreed that this future work should not be exclusively within a single domain. However, it was requested that the history be retained to recognize the work of this domain and project team. It was suggested that the deliverables could be more specific than currently noted (to include guidelines, papers, briefings). However, it was stated that this might create a working party structure in parallel (and not subject to the Bureau). Bureau members also felt strongly that any activities that will result in an external deliverable should go through the existing procedures (the Open Development Process); it is therefore not necessary to have more specific deliverables. Paragraph 37 of the UN/CEFACT ToR/Mandate also underlines how such a group should be set up and how reporting should be performed (to the Bureau).
