The project team had a meeting this morning (4 January), reviewed all the comments and agreed on the final text. The project team requests that the final text be approved to move to the Plenary for final approval.	The Bureau agreed to review and approve the final recommendation text of the TPF Pandemic Crisis project by written procedure decision by Wednesday 6 January COB.
3b. AGRI Textile Traceability Rec project	The AGRI Textile Traceability Recommendation Public Review finished on 24 December 2020. The project team reviewed all comments and agreed on the final text. The project team requests that the final text be approved to move to the Plenary for final approval. 3c. AGRI SDCE RDM project proposal	This project aims to create a contextualized view of the Buy-Ship-Pay Reference Data Model in order to cover sustainable development and circular economy needs. This will compliment the already existing MMT-RDM and SCRDM and the current project on CBM-RDM. It was reminded the technical work of this project and the need to ensure that the experts with the substantive knowledge join the work. Request to launch a new project with proposed project leader Frans van Diepen	Bureau decision 2101076: The Bureau approved the AGRI SDCE RDM project to launch with Frans van Diepen as project leader and supporting Bureau member VC Slot pending three HoD support.
3d. AGRI eCert Guide project	The project team finalized its draft of the eCert Guide and request to move to Public Review. There was a question on the title citing “SPS-part” as the project proposal calls for a single implementation guide and not multiple. Further question on the sub-title “e-Certification” which could cover multiple procedures and not just agriculture. The Bureau agreed that the document title should be modified to “Implementation Guide for UN/CEFACT eCERT standard for SPS”. The updated title will be sent to the project team; if they have no objection, then it will go immediately for Public Review. They will be given a deadline of Wednesday 6 January to respond.
