Support for eCITES BaseSolution deployed in Mozambique

Current Status

UNCTAD eCITES BaseSolution (version 2) deployed on live environment

- ► ANAC started granting CITES Export permits as from 1 February 2023 (13 Permits granted to date)
- ► New/updated version of training materials, to include the latest functionalities introduced by eCITES v2
- ► Continuous support provided to traders & MA staff
- Decision to continue the rollout with the issuance of Permits for non-CITES species













Support for eCITES BaseSolution deployed in Mozambique

Next Steps

Ongoing discussions regarding national extensions and implementation of Augmented Solution. These national extensions for ANAC may include:

- ► Electronic permit exchange with national customs and border control agencies including MOZ Single Window integration
- ► Strengthening of Legal Acquisition Finding: advance quota control, traceability, control of supporting documents, electronic Risk Management when evaluating permit requests
- ► Cross border exchange of CITES permits (EPIX) piloting the solution with South Africa

Submission of UNCTAD project proposal to SPREP for eCITES deployment in Vanuatu








Technical support and continuous improvement
