PPP project – Draft text version 0.11

There was a consensus during the conference call to approve this document. There were two comments which came in by e-mail just before the call which were integrated.

- On legal aspects in PPP Procurement (lines 378-380 of draft version 1.0)
- On aligned documents in the examples of Trade Facilitation PPPs. (lines 180-186 of draft version 1.0)

This document is now considered finalized as the background paper for a recommendation project. This does not exclude any further points from being presented during the next recommendation project.

Proposal for a UN/CEFACT Recommendation on PPP in Trade Facilitation

Comments during the conference call on the project proposal document:

- The section on recommended practice will be omitted in the document which is submitted for approval. HOWEVER, all experts should consider this question and try to develop what recommended practices should be proposed in such a UNECE Recommendation.
 - One recommended practice may be something like: "Governments and those involved in international trade should actively consider implementing trade facilitation through Public-Private Partnership" (followed by a few examples like Rec33).
- Having some case studies very early on in the project would definitely help. It would also be interesting to have different types of projects (research project vs. technology project vs. infrastructure project)...
 - The working group of the future recommendation will need to very quickly elaborate a 'questionnaire' / 'case study format' in order to begin circulating this early on in the project. This could be inspired by the background paper for example...
 - This should be one of the first working items of the new Project Team (perhaps as soon as the Sardinia conference).
 - If you have some suggestions or ideas for this before the meeting in Sardinia, please send these to Lance (<u>lance.thompson@conex.net</u>) or Paloma (<u>pb737@georgetown.edu</u>) before October 11th 2014.
