Major Issue of Interest to the TC

- ITS Corridor Study Group Dr. Vladimir Kryuchkov
 Issue Dr. Kryuchkov has requested comment from TC204
 on his proposed "Smart Silk Road" conference 1-2 Sept
 2016 in Orenburg, Russian Federation with funding from UNESCAP (UN Economic & Social Commission for A/P
 - Conference will highlight: economic factors, legal issues, infrastructure needs, services and <u>technologies</u>
- Proposed response reply from TC chair on behalf of TC204 compliments him on the grand scope and scale of his vision but inform him that TC204 with its lack of resources cannot contribute directly to the conference;

- remind him that TC204 expects him to provide the leadership and resources to begin work on the Intelligent Corridor Study within TC204 in order to identify and develop priority standards;
- TC204 will await the outcome of the conference to learn if UNESCAP can provide funding for the study;
- TC204 recognizes the need for knowledgeable speakers for the five topics of the conference and TC204 may be able to provide advice with respect to speakers related to technology and standards
