









### Complexity of integration of international supply chain

# PortNet: A tool to facilitate the complete integration of the foreign trade for importers and exporters




Thanks to PortNet, this integration is gradually becoming reality due to the interconnection of all stakeholders around the electronic national single window.










# PortNet: An importers and exporters national single window system oriented



### **Learnings from Moroccan experience**

- 1. Align the governance to the interests of the real customers of the single window (importers and exporters) and not only to the interests of some stakeholders. A direct and continuous link with importers and exporters is mandatory;
- 2. Quick Wins are very importants for each of the stakeholders to sustain their commitment and support to the project;
- 3. A single window project is firstly a strategic alliance between the foreign trade stakeholders. They should learn to trust each others and give concessions if needed for the interest of their final clients;
- 4. During the projet, KPIs of all the processes should be always available and updated for all the stakeholders to be able to identify constraints and good solutions for continuous improvement process;
- 5. The regional integration and interoperability should be a goal and taken into consideration earlier.
