RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

UNECE International Conference on Single Window

Nearly 100 participants from over 30 countries participated in this two day conference 30-31 October in Geneva. Various aspects of Single Window were discussed and a number of recommendations resulted, among which a consensus that it is time to launch a revision of Recommendation 33. 30th UN/CEFACT Forum, Rome

The Forum in Rome was very successful, with around 150 experts participating. All the participants and the UNECE were grateful to the Italian External Commerce Agency for hosting the event. A number of projects were launched with success, such as the Single Submission Portal, Smart Containers and Canonical Models, as well as the launch of the two new domains, Harmonization and Communications, both of which attracted a good deal of interest. Three conferences were held, each of which was well attended:

- **Traceability of Sustainable Textile** exposed the importance of transparency in the entire chain to know the environmental, health and workers' conditions in view of a future project.
- **Blockchain,** which presented a number of models for current and potential use of Blockchain and how UN/CEFACT could evolve its deliverables in order to accommodate this technology.
- **30 years of UN/EDIFACT** underlined that despite its age, UN/EDIFACT is still pertinent in today's trading environment, very widely used and even attracting new users every year.

The eCMR project has completed its Public Review and is working on the comments received. It should be finalized soon.
