## Agenda of the meeting

## Details of the discussion

1. Jörg informed the group of the results (see also minutes from previous meeting).  
Action: Use case / business requirements for a Transformation Event API to be provided by Gerhard on behalf of the Textile and Leather project based on "BC Pilot User Manual".
2. No feedback or comments so far.
3. API design rules: Andreas proposes some re-organising of Steve's initial document so that it will be easier for readers to distinguish between essential requirements and "nice to have" specifications.  
Jörg reminded the group that for some technically required artefacts an extension of the CCL will be necessary, but it will take time to include them into the library. Either wait or generate some "makeshift" JSON structures. Sue proposed to help to develop the CCL components so that the PoC can work with a draft CCL export rather than separate structures.  
Action: Andreas to draft a re-organised document structure.
4. TC 154: parallel ISO DCSA project
