Dear Jie,

Here the update. I hope it is clear.

What's the status:

You can consider Deliverables 2, 3, and 4 as nearly finished (about one to two weeks of work remaining to create the new release, D25A). Deliverable 1 will take a bit longer, because it is a high-level BRS, a team decision may be needed on how detailed it should be (such as has been done for the high-level BSP RDM BRS).

I expect this high-level BRS work of approximately 16 pages describing what the RDM encompasses and why it exists could take about one month. As the SDCE RDM already exists and the data is provided by other BRSs (traceability, transparency, circularity), it will essentially be a high-level compilation of those.

What should be done first to get it moving soon:



Sue Probert is the one who prepares the current work for a new release. She has completed some RDMs (e.g., SCRDM, MMT), but not others such as PAY and SDCE. She sent me an email yesterday asking me to verify her work so far. I must report that SDCE has not yet been prepared for a new release.

Status per deliverable:

1. **BRS – Not yet done** due to previous priorities (as reported). This is a large task.
2. **To be done (small)** – These are the so-called message structure masters; without them, no single message structure can be created. Due to Deliverable 3 (the update), this may require a minor revision.
3. **To be done (medium)** – As mentioned in my previous email, about 300 entries have been added to the library and are awaiting inclusion in the new D25A version of the RDM.
4. **Done** – This has already existed for several years.

To consider all items as completed, I would kindly ask the Bureau to extend the project by six months. Remember, due to priorities, this was expected.
